16.2.2 Do recognize an independent students' union (provides input to university, provides support for students, provides social activities?)

The University of Business and technology values the voice and participation of its students in various aspects of its governance and decision-making. Therefore, it adopts appropriate representation of students in the relevant councils and committees, such as the student union council, and the departments' advisory boards. The student councils are composed of elected or nominated student representatives from different faculties, departments, and levels of study. The student representatives act as a bridge between the students and the university, conveying their opinions, concerns, suggestions, and feedback. The Student Union Council Policies and Procedures provide details on the policies of Student Union Council goals duties, responsibilities, and the election procedures and the members nomination conditions (Evidence No. 1 Student Council regulations). The election procedures and process are monitored by the Deanship of Student Affairs (Evidence No. 2 student council activities). Student Union conducts meeting, planning and implementing students' activities(Evidence No3 Student Union council MOM-). The Deanship of Student Affairs conducts a satisfaction survey of each activity including the activities done by the student union council in order to evaluate the effectiveness of the activity and collect students' feedback to better understand and plan for the next activity (Evidence No 4 Satisfaction surveys).
